A public hearing on the budget for the 2024-2025 school year will be held at the White Township Consolidated School Media Center, 565 County Road 519, Belvidere, New Jersey, on Monday, April 29, 2024, at 6:30p.m.

As per N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a), the proposed budget provides for a maximum appropriation amount of \$8,000 that may be allotted for travel and expense reimbursement. The School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs ensuring the maximum amount is not exceeded.

The 2024-2025 budget includes a banked cap of \$96,320 from the prior school year.

The 2024-2025 budget includes a withdrawal from the Capital Reserve in the amount of \$400,000. The use of these funds is for the Rooftop Unit Project including architect and engineering fees. If all funds are

not used by the end of the 2024-2025 budget year, they must be returned to the Capital Reserve Fund by June 30, 2025.

The 2024-2025 budget includes a withdrawal from the Tuition Reserve in the amount of \$50,000. The use of these funds are for High School tuition. If all funds are not used by the end of the 2024-2025 budget year, they must be returned to the Tuition Reserve Fund by June 30, 2025.
