**APPROVE A PLAN FOR REDUCTION TO STATE AID FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR**

A motion was made by Mr. Rader and seconded by Ms. Howell to approve the following plan for the reduction to the district's state aid allocation for the 2018-2019 school year as follows:

Reduce Secretary Salary	11-000-230-100	\$ 20,000
Reduce Teacher Salary	11-110-100-101	\$ 10,000
Reduce Basic Skills Salary	11-230-100-101	\$ 20,000
Use of Unassigned General Fund Surplus		<u>\$ 43,208</u>
Total Reduction		\$101,208

Motion carried as follows: Ms. Howell – yes, Mrs. Sroka – yes, Mrs. Lensi – yes, Mr. Rader – yes, and Mr. Boehm – yes.
