**Grade 5 Art** – 1 two-pocket folder with name and homeroom

**Grade 5 & 6 ELA** - 2 marble composition books in different colors, 1 sturdy two-pocket folder, pencils, pens (not black), sticky notes (medium/standard size) and headphones

**Grade 5 & 6 Health** – 1 two-pocket folder and spiral notebook

**Grade 5 Math** - 1 one-subject notebook and pencils

**Grade 5 Music** - durable pocket folder, pencil, and recorder from third and fourth grade

**Grade 5 Science** – 1 two-pocket folder and spiral notebook

**Grade 5 & 6 Social Studies** - 1 two-pocket folder

**Grade 5 & 6 World Language** – 1 small notebook and 1 two-pocket folder

**Grade 6 Math** – 1 inch binder or a spiral notebook, 1 two-pocket folder, pens, pencils, highlighter, protractor and a ruler

**Grade 7 ELA** - 1 to 1.5 inch three-ring binder with eight dividers, two marble composition books, post-it notes (2x2), highlighters, pens, pencils, a dry-erase marker and one pocket folder and headphones

**Grade 6, 7 & 8 Art** – 1 two-pocket folder and a 9"x12" (or smaller) sketchbook with name and homeroom on both

**Grade 6, 7 & 8 Science** – 1 sturdy pocket folder and pencils

**Grade 6, 7 & 8 World Language** – 1 small notebook and 1 two-pocket

**Grade 7 & 8 Math** - one notebook to get started for the year (2-3 notebooks will be needed for the whole year), pens/pencils/highlighters for note taking and math work, and one folder to keep tests/quizzes/assignments in throughout the year

**Grade 7 & 8 Social Studies** - spiral notebook or three ring binder, jumbo book cover, crayons, colored pencils, pens (assorted and red), a pocket folder, sharpies (fine & medium) optional, and expo markers

**Grade 8 Language Arts** - marble composition book (100 pages), sturdy three subject notebook (with pockets), 3 packs of post-it notes (2x2), multi-colored highlighters, and pens/pencils
